## Assignment 2 Window Lighting

Window light is some of the softest light you can shoot in that is still directional. Your window can be any size or shape. It doesn't even have to be an actual window, it can be any opening.

Keep in mind that different times of day will give different color temperature and different strengths of ratios. Remember to check your white balance settings, do not shoot auto white balance, you will lose any sort of mood you were going for.

ONE OF THESE SHOTS MUST BE BLACK AND WHITE.

Shots:

- 1. A person in window light (no window)
- 2. A person in window light (window in the frame)
- 3. A person in window light with a flash fill.
- 4. Light coming through a window. Shadows and shapes.
- 5. Light coming through a window. Shadows and shapes. With a person.
